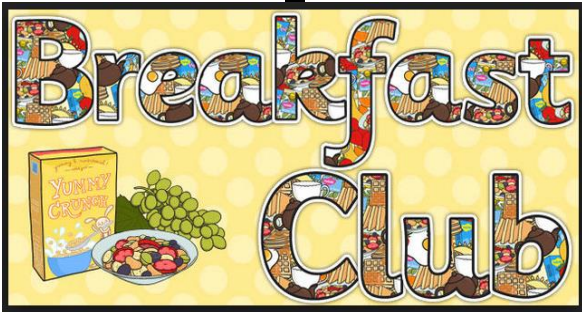
### Cinderella at The Egg
