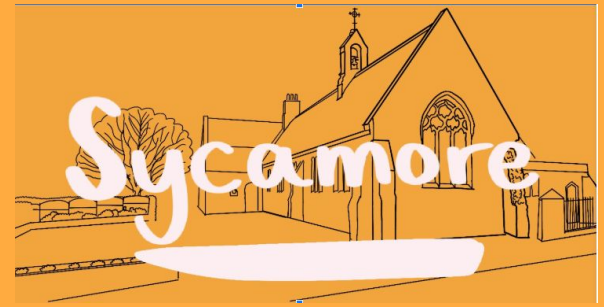

- Or write all the words replacing each vowel with a line. Go back and see if you can fill in the vowels eg q__st__n = question

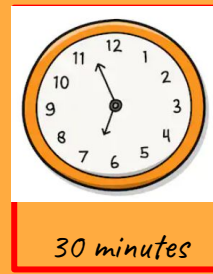

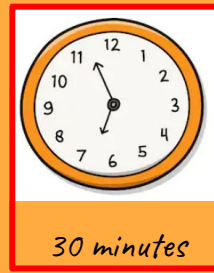

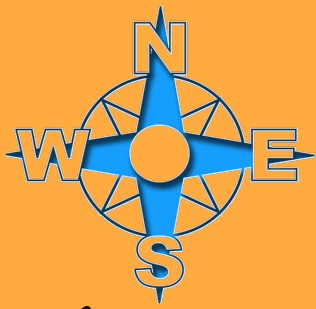
