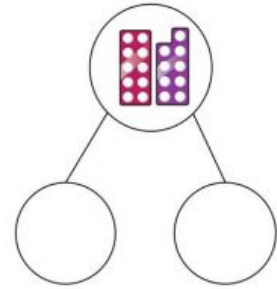

1. Why are monkeys a problem in India ? (p. 8-9)
2. Why is it a problem that racoons and rabbits eat farmers' plants (p. 4 & 11)
3. Why do you think a page on 'Human Invaders' is in the book? (p.14 - 15)

Bluebells: Log into Oxford Owls and re-read 'Tom, Dad and Colin'. Practice the words on the inside front cover and then read the rest of the book, reading as many words on sight as you can. Remember you can read to a pet or a teddy if there's no one who can listen to you today.
