

There was trouble in the toolbox. Thrown together once again, they were getting on each other's nerves, and the saw was feeling rather superior.



Surely I'm the most important tool of all. My sharp teeth can cut into the toughest wood and without my assistance the carpenter couldn't cut wood to the correct length and then nothing would fit properly.



And how would the carpenter ensure the wood was cut to the correct length? By using me of course, the carpenter would use me first, to measure and mark out the wood before cutting it. I'm more important than you are.

Without me the carpenter would still be left with wood that has rough untidy edges that would catch and cut the hands of whoever used it. My sharp blade takes off the rough edges and leave a silky, smooth surface that is a perfect finish. If you are looking for a quality finish then it's me you need. So don't search any further for the most important tool.



What about fine, intricate work? What good is a saw, or plane when you've got to get into small places and cut out intricate shapes? When something special is needed, the carpenter would be lost without me. So don't think you are more important than me.
