If you want you could film yourself reading it and upload to your portfolio.





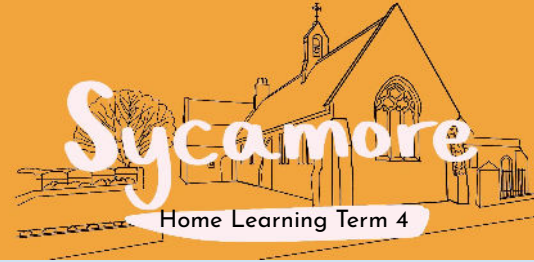

We are going to be learning about alcohol and how it effects on the body.

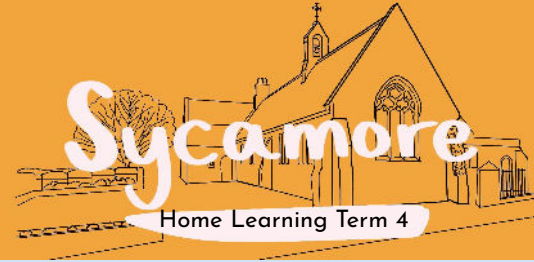
Watch this [film](#) and look at this [powerpoint](#) or [pdf](#) write down any information that tells you how drinking an alcoholic drink changes your body.

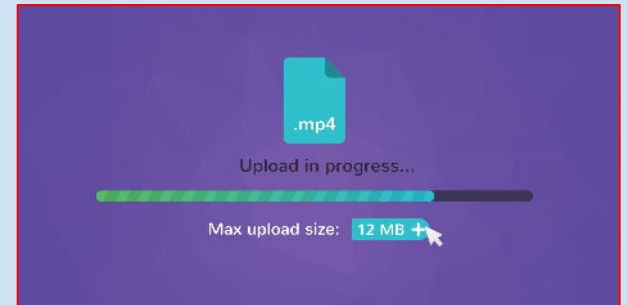
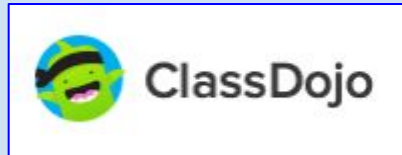
