BaNES Mental Health Support Team (MHST)

Introducing Charlotte, our MHST link



My name is Charlotte and I'm an Education Mental Health Practitioner (EMHP).

I am part of the BaNES Mental Health Support Team (MHST). This is a school-based service, delivered by the NHS.

MHSTs provide low-intensity Cognitive Behavioural Therapy (CBT) interventions for children aged 5-18 struggling with worries, anxiety, low mood or difficulties managing big emotions. These interventions are usually 6-8 sessions. For children under age 7 we typically offer parent interventions only.

CBT is based on the idea that our thoughts, feelings, and behaviours are all connected. By learning to change our thoughts and behaviours, we can start to feel better.

MHSTs also support schools with their 'whole school approach' to mental health and well-being by offering assemblies, workshops and group sessions for children, workshops and groups for parents, and staff trainings.

To enquire about support from the MHST, please speak to Charlotte Webb who can make a referral on your behalf.

If your child is referred to our team, we will contact you to arrange an initial assessment for them. Following this, we will work together to come up with a plan of how best to help your child.
